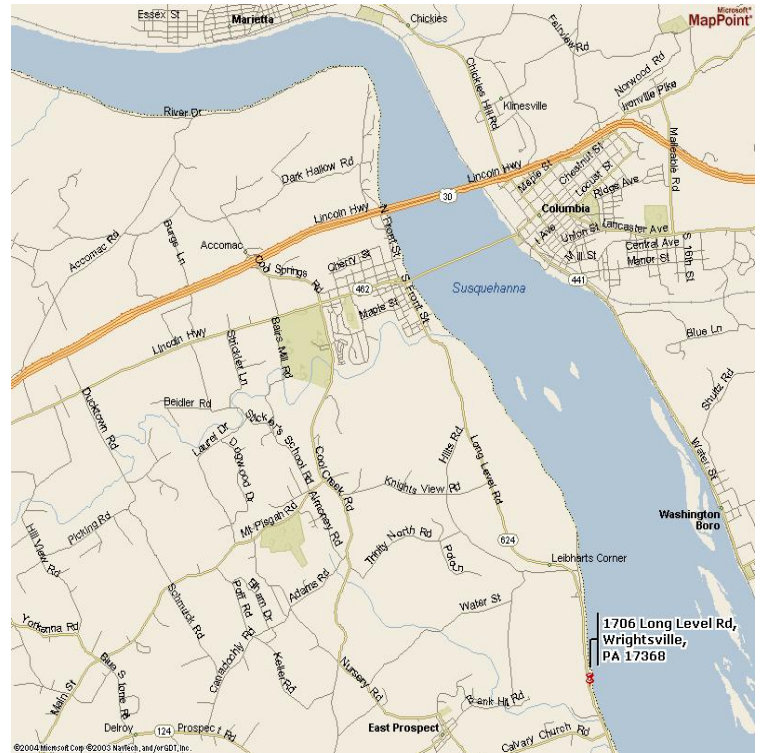
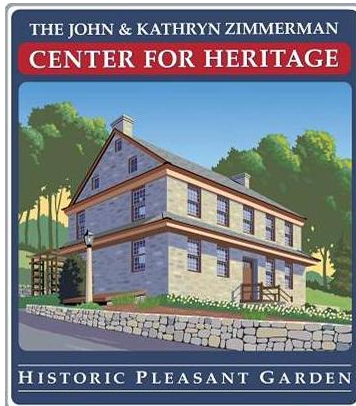

Driving Directions:

From York

Take US Route 30 to the Wrightsville exit.
At the top of the ramp, turn right onto Cold Springs Rd.
At the traffic light crossing over Rt. 462 (aka Lincoln Highway and Hellam Street) go straight. The road becomes Cool Creek Rd.
Take Cool Creek Road up the hill, past the golf course.
Just before you reach Eastern York High School, turn left onto Knights View Rd.
Take Knights View Rd until it ends at Long Level Rd (also Rt. 624). (The *Highpoint Scenic Vista & Recreation Area* of the Susquehanna Heritage Park will be on left.)
Turn right onto Long Level Rd (Rt. 624).
Follow Long Level Rd past *Klines Run Park*.
We are located on the right side of the road. If you reach Long Level Marina, you have gone too far.

From Lancaster

Take US Route 30 to the Columbia/Marietta exit.
Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Rt. 441 South.
At the traffic light in Columbia where Rt. 441 meets Rt. 462, turn right onto Rt. 462.
Proceed over the Columbia-Wrightsville Bridge.
At the end of the bridge, make a sharp right onto Hellam St. Hellam St ends at Front St. Turn right onto South Front St (also called Rt. 624 South).
Continue on this road. You will pass a quarry on the right, and the road becomes Long Level Rd (still Rt. 624). You will pass the *Highpoint Scenic Vista & Recreation Area* of the Susquehanna Heritage Park (on right at the crest of the hill.)
Follow Long Level Rd past *Klines Run Park*.
We are located on the right side of the road. If you reach Long Level Marina, you have gone too far.

Parking is available in the rear of the house or on the circular portion of the front drive. Please do not park along the street. Our main entrance is off the patio in the back.
