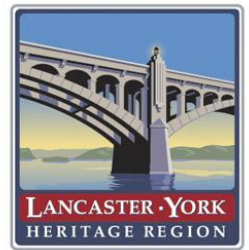

Wrightsville, PA – The Lancaster-York Heritage Region cordially invites the public to attend The River Experience on Saturday, June 20, 2009, from 6 – 9 p.m., on the riverfront grounds of Shank’s Mare Outfitters, just south of Wrightsville. In addition to Susquehanna River pontoon boat rides, live music, living history and a silent auction, the evening will feature food and beverage tastings from local restaurants, wineries and breweries. Participating venues include: Bube’s Brewery, Bully’s Pub & Restaurant, Lancaster Brewing Company, Lock 2 Café (featuring Stone River Farms and Sparky & Clark’s), Miller’s Smorgasbord, Moon Dancer Winery, Naylor Wine Cellars, Inc., Nissley Vineyards and Winery Estate, Prudhomme’s Lost Cajun Kitchen, the Flour Child Pastry & Bake Shop, the John Wright Restaurant, the Wrightsville Inn & Creative Caterers, and Turkey Hill Ice Cream.
